# How 15 hours free early education are calculated:

Is calculated: 15 hrs per week x 38 (weeks) = 570 per annum

Entitlement: 15 hrs per week for 38 weeks per year.

## Eligibility

How it works: All 3 to 4-year-olds and some 2-year-olds in England can get 15 hours per week for 38 weeks per year, that's 570 hours of free early education (F.E.E) per year. The date you can start claiming depends on your child's birthday.

#### Child's birthday

When you can claim 1 January to 31 March Beginning of term on or after 1 April 1 April to 31 August Beginning of term on or after 1 September 1 September to 31 December Beginning of term on or after 1 January

#### Understanding 15hrs F.E.E

Here at Early Learners, we can offer the entitlement across 38 weeks to support the working parent and consistency for the children. Parents are never charged for E.E.E. hours. The E.E.E. does not include breakfast or nursery meals, additional services are chargeable. The date you can start claiming depends on your child's birthday. A calendar is provided when you start. The nursery is closed for 1 week between Christmas and New Year. Providers cannot use more than 10 hours within one day.

Government funding is intended to deliver 'Free Early Education' (F.E.E) each week of free, high quality, flexible childcare. It is not intended to cover the costs of meals, other consumables, additional hours or additional services. Ref: Early years entitlements: operational guidance for local authorities and providers. We only accept regular sessions and monthly payment is due in advance. Our Pre-School Bundle(s) is not available on 'term-time' only services.
